Each team needs to have a volunteer be the Little Scholars Coordinator!

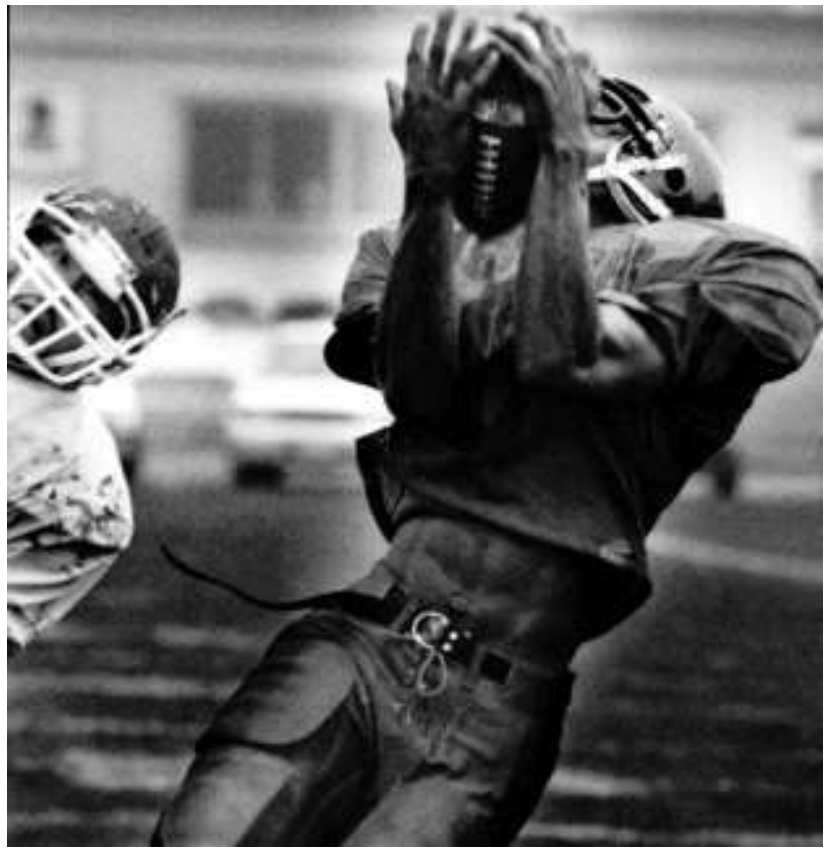

Scholastics team coordinators will be responsible for the following:

- ▲ Calculating the report cards and sending a spreadsheet with player names and GPAs to the League.
- ▲ Determine which players are eligible for MidValley Pop Warner's scholastic recognition and if the player is eligible for the All-American Program and help motivate parents to fill out the All-American Scholar application.
- ▲ For those players who filled out a Scholastics Eligibility Form, collect progress reports dated between Sept. 16 to Oct. 16. A copy of the form is kept with the player's report card in the team book and the other must be faxed to 1-800-960-4568.
- ▲ If player qualifies for All-American Program, assist player with filling out the All American Application. An important component of this application is the player's community involvement.
- ▲ Parents of pre-schoolers and kindergarteners must sign the Pre-School and Kindergarten Academic waiver form.



Question: Who is eligible for the Scholar All-American Program?

Answer: Players must meet the following criteria:

1. Currently in the 5th grade or higher
2. Have a 96% grade point average (GPA) from the 2008-2009 school year's report card.
3. Provide a complete, full year's report card from the 2008-2009 school year.
4. Fill out the All-American Application and turn it into MVPW by October 1.

Question: Who is eligible for the MidValley Pop Warner Program?

Answer: Players must meet the following criteria:

1. Have a 86% Grade Point Average (GPA) from the 2008-2009 school year's report card.
2. Provide a complete, full year's report card from the 2008-2009 school year.
3. 1st through 8th graders are eligible to receive recognition.
